## Our student teachers, Miss Wall and Miss Hepburn, from University of Hertfordshire

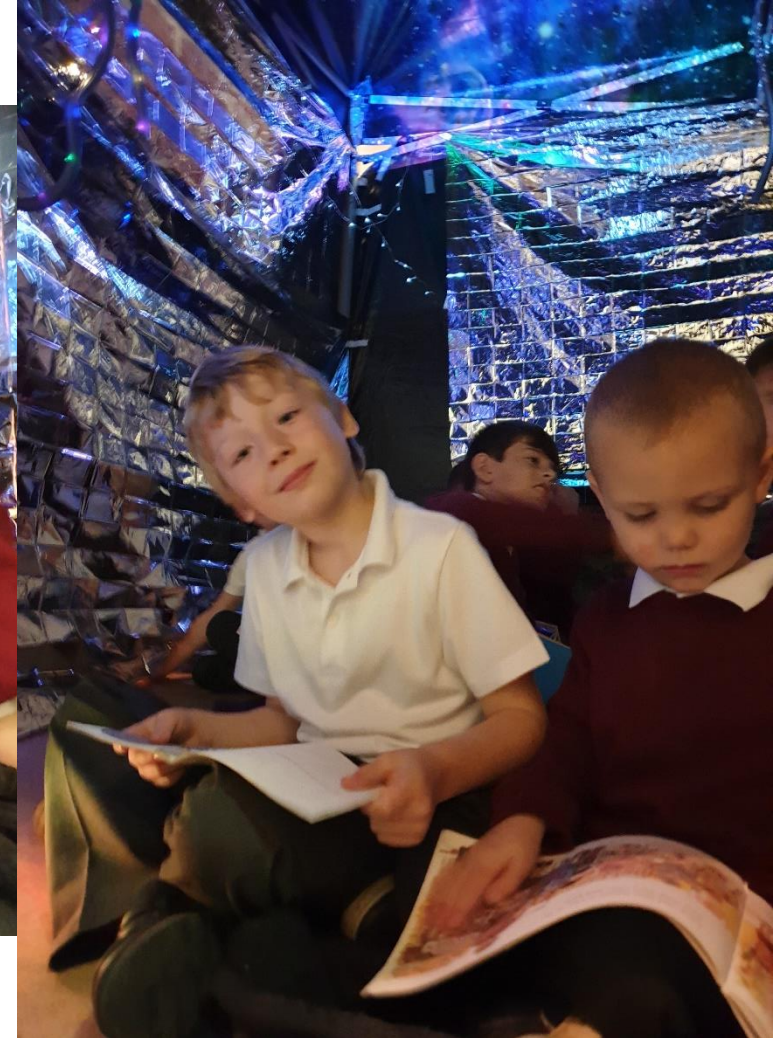


Working with the University of Hertfordshire, we have been very lucky to have two wonderful student teachers helping us over the term and will be with us until February.

# Forest School fun



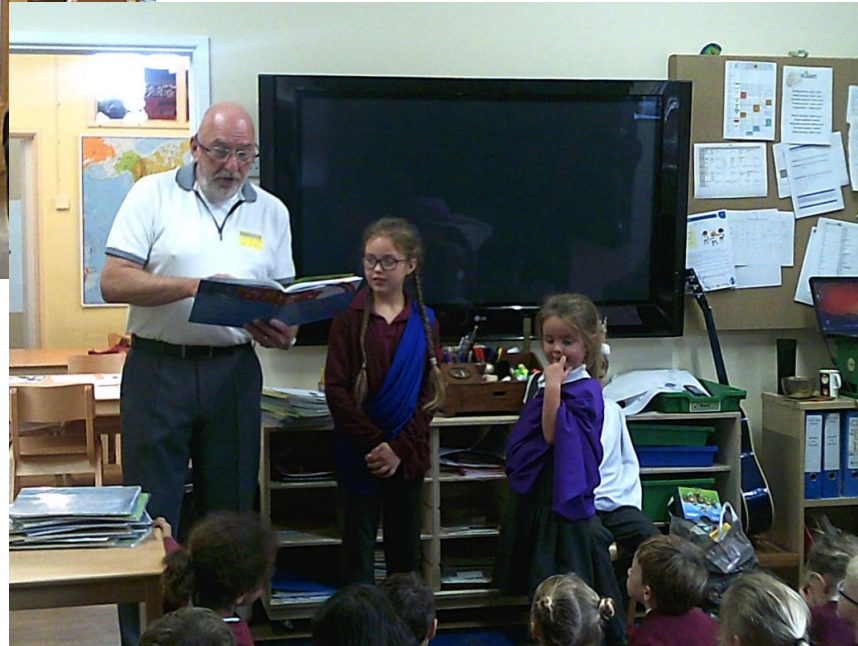
We work together in mixed age groups to help develop leaderships skills for our older children in helping our younger pupils.

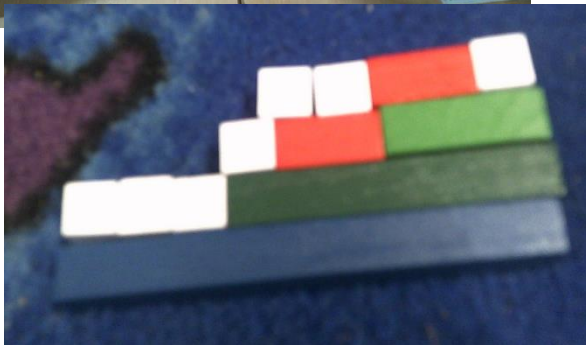

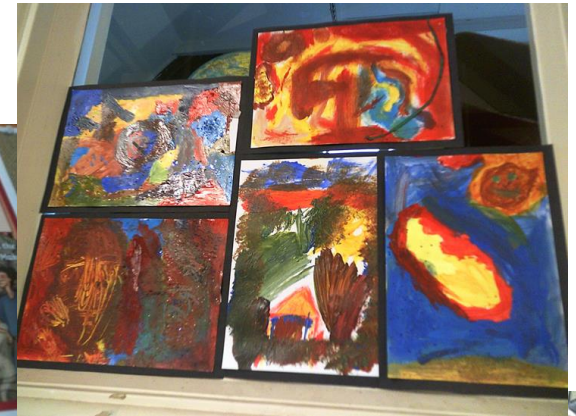
